**Subject: Administrative Modification #3 to the 2017 Federal Transportation Improvement Program**

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Dear Mr. Aljabiry,

Please be advised that the San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG) made changes to the 2017 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). The SJCOG Executive Director has the authority to approve all administrative modifications. The proposed modifications are consistent with the 2014 Regional Transportation Plan (as amended) and Public Participation Plan (as amended) adopted by the SJCOG Board of Directors.

SJCOG FTIP Administrative Modification #3 amends the costs to the following projects in the 2017 FTIP:

- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0313: Grouped Projects for Safety Improvements – Collision Reduction: Adds PE phases for two projects in Fiscal Year 2016/17 totaling \$2,084,000 of SHOPP funds, and adds one new project in Fiscal Year 2017/18 totaling \$1,007,000 of SHOPP funds.
- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0432: Grouped Projects for Safety Improvements – Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction - SHOPP: Adds funding for PE phase for one project in Fiscal Year 2016/17 totaling \$4,869,000 of SHOPP funds, and adds two new projects in Fiscal Year 2018/19 totaling \$7,630,000 of SHOPP funds.
- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0552: Lockeford Street Improvements: Clarifies limits of project as beginning at the UPRR instead of Main Street in Lodi. Updates scope and project name. Reduces City Funds for CON phase by \$3,612,481 in Fiscal Year 2017/18.
- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0624: HBRR Buckman Road Bridge No. 29C0307: Increases HBP funds for CON phase by \$161,602 in Fiscal Year 2020/21, beyond the four-year period of the FTIP.

- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0661: Mt. Diablo / Mt. Oso / C St. Improvements (Tracy – Regional ATP): Adds \$306,000 of City Funds for CON phase in Fiscal Year 2016/17.

SJCOG certifies that this modification contains an exempt project and does not require a conformity re-determination. SJCOG also certifies that this modification does not impact the timely implementation of any TCMs and that no project included in this modification is included in any other amendment or modification to the FTIP currently out for public review or approval.
