Subject: Administrative Modification #21 to the 2017 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP)

Dear Mr. Aljabiry,

Please be advised that the San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG) made changes to the 2017 FTIP. The SJCOG Executive Director has the authority to approve all administrative modifications. The proposed modifications are consistent with the 2014 Regional Transportation Plan (as amended) and Public Participation Plan (as amended) adopted by the SJCOG Board of Directors. SJCOG FTIP Administrative Modification #21 amends the costs to the following projects in the 2019 FTIP:

- <u>CTIPS ID 212-0000-0213: Manteca Transit Operations</u> Increases FTA 5307 funds by \$175,000 in FY 17/18, FY 18/19, and FY 19/20. Increases TDA funds by \$175,000 in FY 17/18, 18/19, and FY 19/20.
- <u>CTIPS ID 212-0000-0300: Safety and Security Manteca</u> Adds \$99,999 of FTA 5307 funds and \$20,000 of TDA funds in FY 17/18, and adds contracted security services to project scope.
- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0687: Bus Replacements Adds \$560,000 of FTA 5310 funds in FY 16/17. Removes \$545,120 of FTA 5337 funds in FY 17/18 and \$556,166 of FTA 5337 funds in FY 18/19.
- <u>CTIPS ID 212-0000-0696: Miner Avenue Complete Street Phase 1</u> Shifts \$2,000 of ATP funds from CON phase in FY 17/18 to PE Phase in FY 16/17.
- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0721: Lowell Avenue Sidewalk Construction Project Shifts \$232,000 of ATP funds and \$63,000 of City Funds for CON phase from FY 19/20 to FY 18/19. Identifies ATP funds as State-Only SB 1 Funds per ATP Augmentation.

• <u>CTIPS ID 212-0000-0722: RTD's Bike and Bus Transportation Project</u> – Removes \$152,000 of ATP funds and \$122,000 of Measure K funds for CON phase in FY 19/20. Adds \$198,000 of ATP funds and \$74,000 of Measure K Funds for CON Phase in FY 18/19. Identifies ATP funds as State-Only SB 1 Funds per ATP Augmentation.

In addition, for your information SJCOG has updated the Regionally Significant Project List contained within the 2017 FTIP.

With the modifications identified in this document, the SJCOG 2017 FTIP remains financially constrained. SJCOG certifies that this modification contains exempt projects and does not require a conformity re-determination. 
