Subject: Administrative Modification #25 to the 2017 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP)

Dear Mr. Aljabiry,

Please be advised that the San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG) made changes to the 2017 FTIP. The SJCOG Executive Director has the authority to approve all administrative modifications. The proposed modifications are consistent with the 2014 Regional Transportation Plan (as amended) and Public Participation Plan (as amended) adopted by the SJCOG Board of Directors. SJCOG FTIP Administrative Modification #25 amends the costs to the following projects in the 2019 FTIP:

- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0001: Grouped Projects for Pavement Resurfacing and/or Rehabilitation – Adjusts grouped listing to reflect current project understanding. Increases RSTP funds by \$1,427,000 in FY 16/17 and \$1,054,497 in FY 17/18. Decreases RSTP funds by \$3,083,871 in FY 19/20. Adjusts list of projects in FY 16/17, FY 17/18, and FY 19/20.
- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0313: Grouped Projects for Safety Improvements – SHOPP Collision Reduction – Adds two new projects from 2018 SHOPP to grouped listing. Project EA 1C760 adds \$1,625,000 of SHOPP AC funds in FY 18/19 for PA&ED and PS&E Phases only. Project EA 1C970 adds \$1,549,000 of SHOPP AC funds in FY 18/19 for PA&ED and PS&E Phases only.
- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0315: Grouped Projects for Roadway Preservation – SHOPP – Adds one new project from 2018 SHOPP to grouped listing, project EA 1E610 adds \$1,969,000 of SHOPP AC funds in FY 18/19 for PA&ED and PS&E Phases only.
- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0432: Grouped Projects for Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction – SHOPP – Adjusts programming of project EA 1H342 in FY 19/20 to add \$9,910,000 of SHOPP AC funds to fully fund the project through CON phase.

- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0669: Grouped Projects for Safety Improvements – SHOPP Mandates Program – Adds one new project from 2018 SHOPP to grouped listing, project EA 1G550 with increase of \$1,056,000 of SHOPP AC funds in FY 18/19 for PA&ED and PS&E Phases only.
- CTIPS ID 212-0000-0154: Lodi Transit Operating Assistance – Decreases FTA 5307 funds by \$1,400,000 in FY 18/19 and FY 19/20. Decreases Measure K funds by \$400,000 in FY 18/19 and FY 19/20. Decreases TDA funds by \$1,600,000 in FY 18/19 and FY 19/20. Decreases City Funds by \$450,000 in FY 18/19 and FY 19/20.

With the modifications identified in this document, the SJCOG 2017 FTIP remains financially constrained. SJCOG certifies that this modification contains exempt projects and does not require a conformity re-determination. SJCOG also certifies that this modification does not impact the timely implementation of any TCMs and that no project included in this modification is included in any other amendment or modification to the FTIP currently out for public review or approval.
