Mobility Hub Tracy Transit Station

A mobility hub is a central, accessible location where multiple modes of transportation such as buses, bike share, ride-hailing, electric vehicle charging, and pedestrian pathways connect seamlessly. It's designed to make travel safer, greener, and more convenient for everyone, especially those who rely on public transportation.

The Tracy Mobility Hub will improve travel choices, reduce emissions, and support housing and jobs by connecting people to key destinations such as transit lines, downtown areas, and major corridors.

Why the Tracy Transit Station?


A key site chosen for its potential to demonstrate how regional and local services can work together efficiently.

Amenities

- 1 Secure micromobility location to accommodate bikekeep smart racks
- 2 Improve existing bike lockers with:
 - Fix-it repair stand and air pump
 - E-bike charging stations
 - Locker misuse detection software
- 3 Two new public e-charging parking stalls
- 4 Proposed curb ramp and onstallation of marked crosswalk
- 5 Install real-time display at bus stop shelter
- 6 Flower fountain treatment *
- 7 Update park & ride sign to better advertise carpool program with QR code/branding
- 8 Proposed 100' rideshare pickup & dropoff zone
- 9 Proposed that three existing parking spaces be replaced with raised Park & Ride seating with shelter.
- 10 Park & ride information kiosk
- 11 Three picnic table/seating with umbrella
- 12 Accent string lighting attached to existing light post
- 13 Blank wall facade treatment *
- 14 Concrete planter retrofit treatment
- 15 Enhance crosswalk striping and optional pedestrian lighting *
- 16 Install two accessible parking stalls (1 being van accessible)
- 17 Accessible path from pickup & dropoff zone
