Stockton Metropolitan Airport Terminal Modernization and Expansion

Project Summary:

The existing terminal building at the Stockton Metropolitan Airport (SCK) was constructed in 1960. The facility houses a number of Airport functions, including airline operations, a public lobby and restroom facilities, a Transportation Security Agency (TSA) checkpoint, checked baggage inspection, airline ticket, Airport Administration offices, one restaurant, various business offices, and a passenger hold room. Due to the age of the facility and the latest growth forecast the Airport completed a terminal needs assessment to identify the specific requirements for modernization and expansion of the facility to meet anticipated demand.
