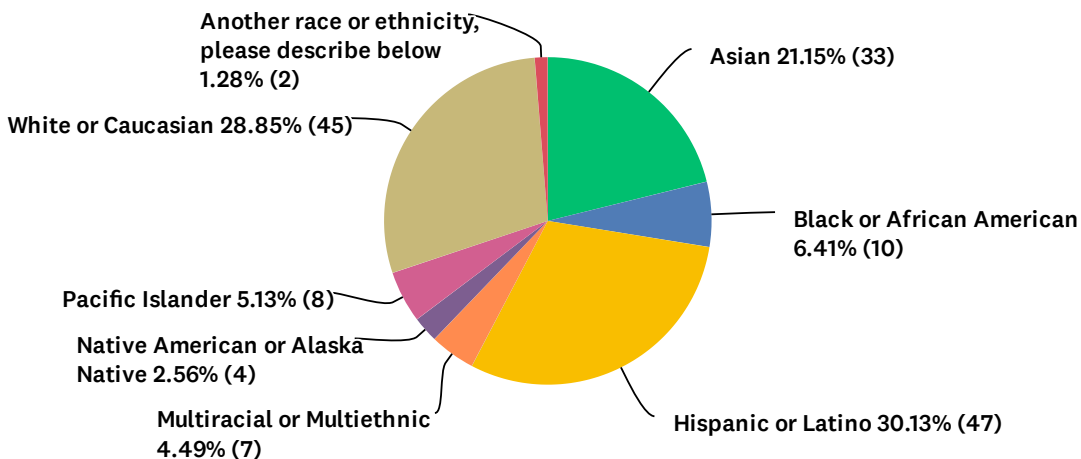

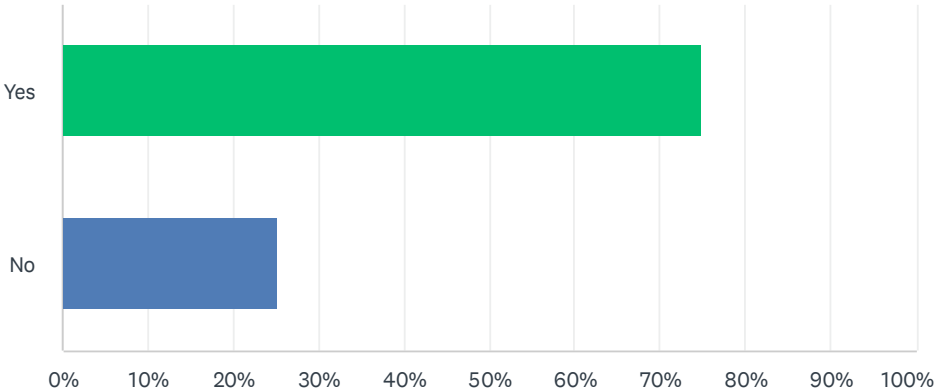

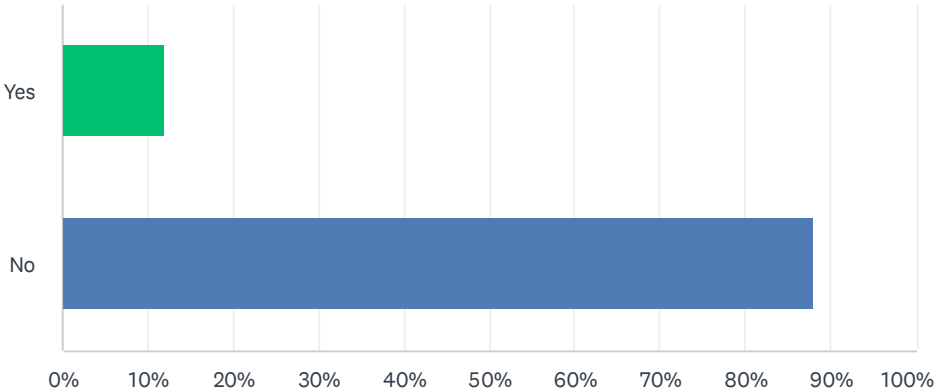

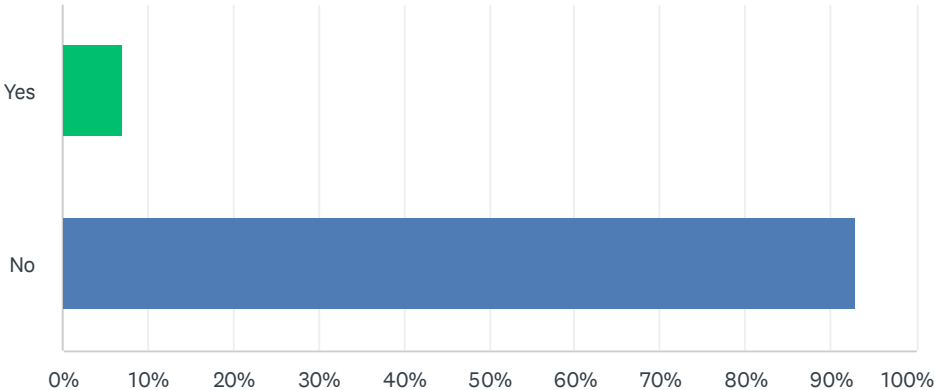

Q8 Are you a person living with a disability?

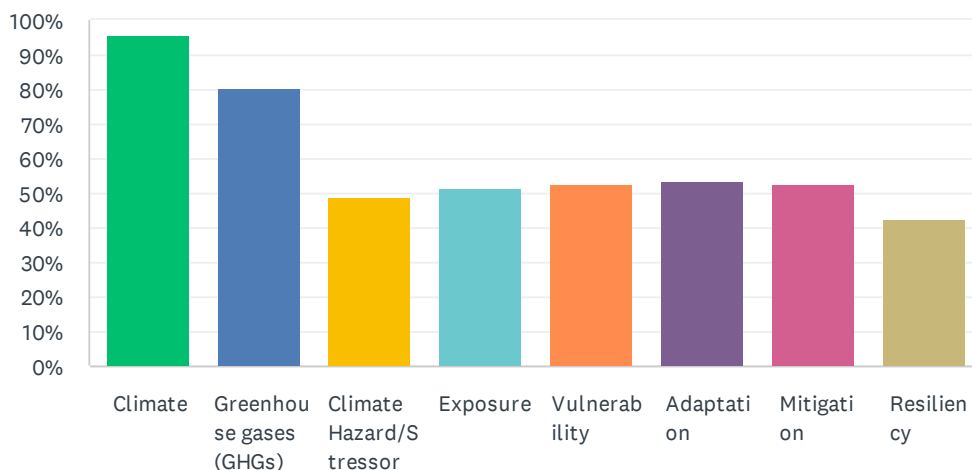

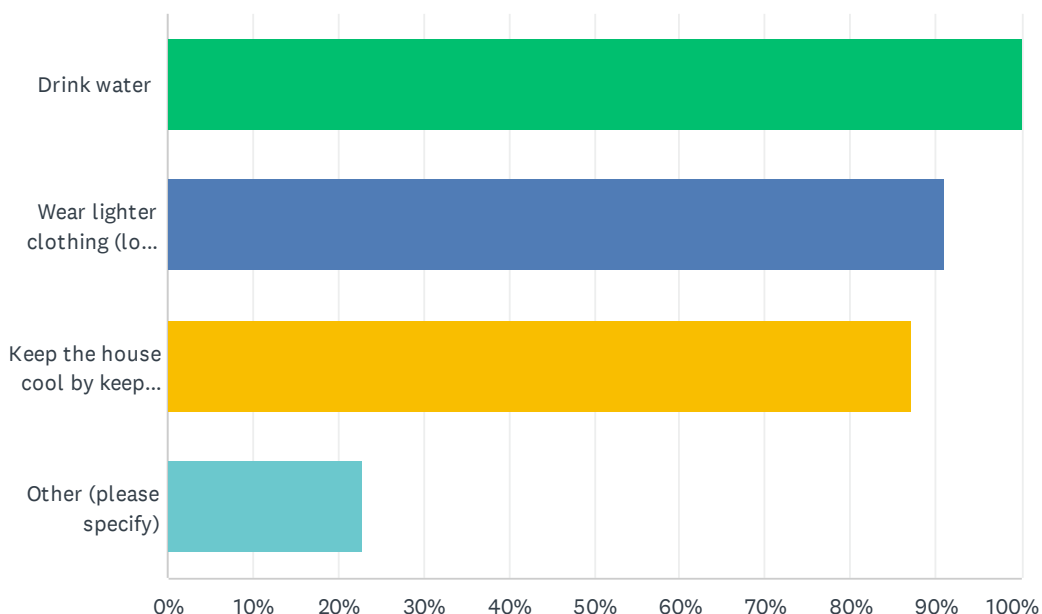
